Levels and Methods

Levels

The learning programme is divided into **four levels**: basic (level A2 according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages - CEFR -), elementary (level B1), intermediate (level B2) and sufficiency (level C1), with each level containing three courses. Each course requires approximately 45 hours of study.

Methods

Two **learning methods** are available:

Self-managed learning

This allows you to study in a completely independent way, as the course materials can be easily accessed.

With this method, courses are free of charge.

With a tutor

This allows you to study with the support of a tutor, who will provide guidance and encouragement.

With this method, courses are of payment.
